

Terms and Conditions

Habitat Drones and Environmental Services – Agricultural Drone Spraying Services

1. Scope of Services

Habitat Drones and Environmental Services (“we”, “us”, or “our”) provides aerial spraying services using unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs/drones) for agricultural, forestry, and environmental management purposes. Services include application of pesticides, herbicides, fertilizers, and biological agents, as agreed upon in writing.

2. Client Responsibilities

Clients must provide accurate, up-to-date maps of the area to be treated and identify any hazards (e.g., power lines, structures, water sources, sensitive crops).

Clients must ensure legal access to land and confirm that all permits and permissions are in place for aerial spraying.

Clients must inform us of any organic certification or drift-sensitive neighboring properties.

3. Safety and Compliance

All operations are conducted in accordance with applicable aviation, environmental, and chemical-use regulations.

Weather conditions (e.g., wind, rain, temperature) may impact scheduling; we reserve the right to reschedule if conditions are unsafe or non-compliant.

Drone operations are conducted by licensed UAV operators and certified chemical applicators.

4. Scheduling and Cancellation

Cancellations made less than 24 hours before the scheduled time may incur a cancellation fee.

We reserve the right to postpone or cancel service due to weather, equipment issues, or regulatory restrictions.

Weather and solar conditions can create no fly days. 50% stand by rates apply.

5. Payment Terms

Payment is due within 7 days of invoice unless otherwise agreed in writing.

A late fee of 2% per month may be applied to overdue invoices.

Additional costs incurred due to client delays or scope changes may be billed separately.

6. Liability and Indemnity

While we take all reasonable precautions, we are not liable for crop damage, solar panel damage, drift onto neighboring properties, or non-target impact caused by inaccurate site information, unforeseeable weather shifts, or external interference.

The client agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Habitat Drones and Environmental Services from any claims arising from improper landowner authorization, miscommunication about sensitive areas, or third-party complaints.

7. Environmental Responsibility

We aim to minimize environmental impact and use best-practice methods for precision application and drift reduction.

Clients are encouraged to inform us of any ecologically sensitive areas that require protection.

8. Data and Privacy

Data collected during drone operations (maps, flight logs, application data) remains our property unless otherwise agreed.

We do not share client information or data with third parties without consent, except where required by law.

9. Force Majeure

We are not responsible for delays or non-performance due to events beyond our control, including natural disasters, regulatory changes, or drone airspace restrictions.
